

Routine Smear Test





Cervical screening (a smear test) checks the health of your cervix which is part of the female reproductive system.



All women and people with a cervix aged 25 to 64 should be invited by letter.



Smears tests are carried out at GP Surgeries by a nurse.



You will need to make an appointment for a smear test.



You can ask someone you trust to support you with booking a smear test.



During the screening appointment, a small sample of cells will be taken from your cervix.



The sample of cells will be examined, tested and results will be sent to you directly.
